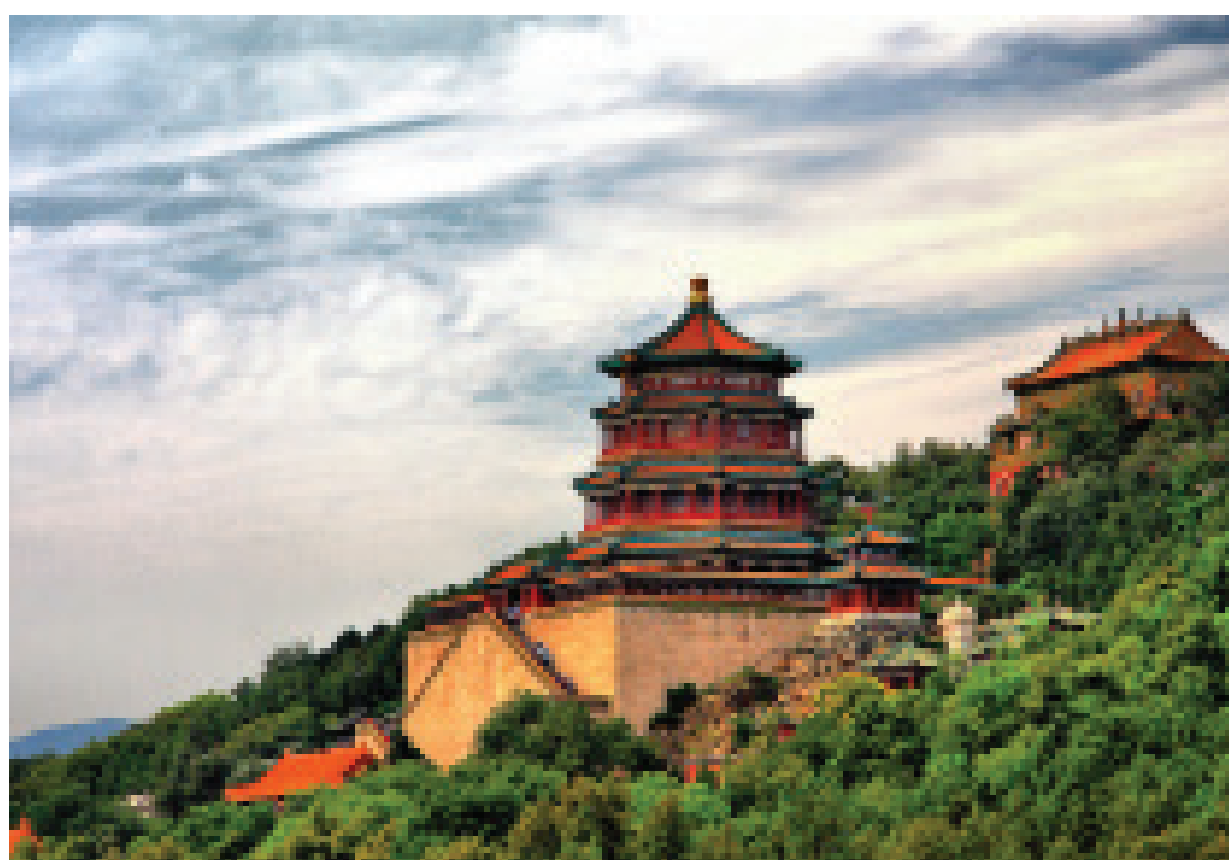

Morning: Layers of Beijing Walking Tour

Morning: Tai Chi in the Temple of Heaven

The Temple of Heaven is one of Beijing's most rewarding early morning sights - a great place to witness Beijing's old folk singing songs and playing games. You'll take a relaxing hour-long tai chi class among the temple's centuries-old cypresses with a former Shaolin monk and learn about the philosophy behind this ancient martial art to boot.

Morning: The Great Wall at Mutianyu

Enjoy an hour hiking China's most famous monument with a guide who will dispel the myths and reveal the Wall's fascinating history. We love this section for its mixture of old and restored ramparts and - this is the fun part - the toboggan ride down! (Don't worry, there's a chairlift too)



Lunch at Xiaolumian

Located in a weathered stone farmhouse on a hill overlooking the Great Wall at Mutianyu, Xiaolumian offers a step up from traditional homemade Chinese noodles. A hearty lunch to keep you going until dinner!



Afternoon: Tour the Forbidden City

The jewel in Beijing's crown, the Forbidden City housed 24 emperors over the course of 500 years. The palace's history is rich with stories of murder, intrigue and betrayal - all of which will be brought to life by your guide - an American historian specializing late Imperial and modern Chinese history.
